Tasting Note - April, 2013

- Colour:** Deep cherry red.
Nose: Fresh lifted mulberry / raspberry fruit and light mocha aromatic is nicely weighted by subtle oak.
Palate: Medium bodied with fresh, crisp acidity and nice length of fruit. Persistent finish with long fruity after taste.
Potential: This vintage has produced fruity wines that have medium term cellaring potential.
Foods: Steak, lamb roasts and hearty stews.
Technical: Alcohol: 14.0% , pH 3.50, TA 6.4
Vintage: The 2012 vintage was excellent in all our regions with excellent ripeness and acidity.
